Course / Presentation Types

Cold class sessions will have a room setup in classroom or theater style. (**No PPE Required**)
H.O.T. classes (*Requiring **Any** Appropriate PPE*)

Selection Process

The OSFA Educational Advisory Committee and other subject matter experts will review all submissions and select sessions based on relevance, timeliness of content, and instructor qualifications.

Room Setup and Equipment for "Cold" sessions

Rooms will be set up in theater or classroom style. Each room will consist of a laptop, podium, projector and screen. There will be no internet provided, so be sure to download all presentation material to thumb drive for upload at the training site. If you have any other special classroom needs, other than items listed above, please include them in your submission.

Please list any materials or equipment that may be needed or you can provide to support this presentation. This includes, any partnerships with a specific vendor or company.

- Individuals must complete the submission process in its entirety. Incomplete submissions will not be accepted.

1. Enter session submission
 - A. Provide a Title (*10 words or less*)
 - B. Provide contact information
 - C. Select the appropriate ability level for the session:
 - Basic
 - Intermediate
 - Advanced
 - D. Provide Session Description (*30 words or less*). If selected, this description will be used in marketing materials and attendee guides. This description should "sell" your session in the most concise and creative way.
 - E. Identify the proposed subject matter category:
 - Fire
 - Law Enforcement
 - EMS
 - Emergency Management
 - Communications
 - F. Provide at least *three (3)* learning objectives for the session.
2. Add Presenters
 - A. Provide Bio for all presenters (*150 words*)
 - B. Include name and contact of any co-presenters
3. Submit Proposal
 - A. Please make sure all sections are complete.
 - B. Review for accuracy, make any edits or revisions

- C. Submit for review. (Online through OSFA website www.osfa.info ; hand deliver or mail to OSFA Office @ 2716 N.E. 50th OKC, OK 73111; or email to rileyb@osfa.info or stevel@osfa.info.)
- If selected, all presenters agree to the following:
 - Deliver presentation(s) at dates and times assigned;
 - Grant permission to be photographed or digitally captured;
 - If the submission is selected, OSFA reserves the right to revise program titles and edit the program summary for promotional materials associated with the 2018 fire school for marketing purposes.
 - Please include your maximum & minimum enrollment for your class or presentation.
 - **All Presentations will be selected no later than January 15th, 2018.**
