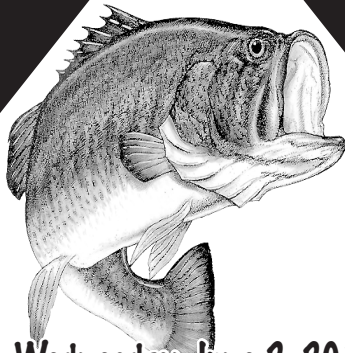

BASS TOURNAMENT RULES:

- 1) **SAFETY:** Safe motoring conduct must be observed at all times. No alcoholic beverages will be allowed before or during the tournament. Each contestant must wear USCG-approved life preserver anytime the big motor is in operation. All boats must be equipped with an operational kill switch attached to life preserver. OSFA will not be held responsible for any accidents.
- 2) **ELIGIBILITY:** Teams will consist of two participants. One current/retired or volunteer fire department member must be on each team.
- 3) **ENTRY FEES:** Tournament entry fees shall be \$60 per boat. Please make check/money orders payable to OSFA Bass Tournament 2010. Mail-in entry fees must be postmarked no later than May 19, 2010. Late entry fees will be accepted at the ramp prior to launch but will include a \$10 late fee and must be paid in cash.
- 4) **PERMITTED FISHING METHODS:** All bass must be caught live in a conventional sporting manner. Only artificial lures may be used with the exception of pork trailers. Bank fishing or trolling is prohibited.
- 5) **LEGAL FISH:** 5) LEGAL FISH: Only Largemouth, Smallmouth, Kentucky or Spotted Bass will be legal tournament fish. Fish will be measured with the mouth closed and tail pinched on a golden rule board and must be 14" or longer. All fish become the property of OSFA and will be released after weigh-in.
- 6) **PENALTIES:** Every effort must be made to keep fish alive. Any dead fish weighed in will result in an 8 ounce deduction from the total weight for each dead fish. Any short fish brought to weigh-in will result in the largest fish in creel to be disqualified. Only one courtesy bump per boat if requested. Contestants must be at the official check in point on time or will be penalized one pound per minute deducted from total weight. Any contestant more than five minutes late will be disqualified.
- 7) **DISQUALIFICATIONS:** No fishing will be permitted within fifty (50) yards of another team. Eufala Cove, inside the tire break is off limits. Any violation of rules may result in disqualification.
- 8) **PROTEST:** Protest may be filled in writing within 10 minutes after weigh-in to the tournament official.
- 9) **TAKE OFF AND CHECK-IN:** All boats will be launched at Eufala Cove City Ramp. No trailering will be allowed. All contestants must have their boat checked in prior to launch. Take off order will be determined by order that entry fees are received in the mail. Boats will be released for take off one at a time by the tournament official in the flag boat. Boats must idle past flag boat before taking off.
- 10) **INTERPRETATION OF RULES:** Interpretation of these rules will be at the discretion of the tournament official and all decisions will be final.
