#1 Nozzle person:

Full PPE

1.5 Hoseline

45 degree off of bumper

Don't go: In front of engine
Past Drivers rear-view mirror

Stop at ¼ of water left in tank

BRUSH ?

- Operator:
- Scout line
- Don't "push" nozzle
- Stop if you can't see nozzle person
- Monitor radio as needed
- Stop at ¼ tank of water left in tank
- Full PPE
- Shelter immediately available
- Watch Mirrors for spot fires behind engine

OFFICER RESPONSIBILITIES

- MONITOR LCES AT ALL TIMES**
- Full PPE
- Hand tool if not using a hand line
- Primary Lookout for your Engine
- Watch Weather/Fuels/Topography/Fire behavior
- Direct crew doing operations
- Ensure objectives are being accomplished
- Watch for Spot fires behind apparatus
- Flow water from second line if needed.
- Communicate with other units as needed
- Scout travel route
- Monitor Tank Water Level. Retain ¼ for personal protection
